

## Jeremiah 17:1-13 CSB

Jeremiah 17:1-13 CSB <sup>1</sup> The sin of Judah is inscribed with an iron stylus. With a diamond point it is engraved on the tablet of their hearts and on the horns of their altars, <sup>2</sup> while their children remember their altars and their Asherah poles, by the green trees on the high hills-<sup>3</sup> my mountains in the countryside. I will give up your wealth and all your treasures as plunder because of the sin of your high places in all your borders. <sup>4</sup> You will, on your own, relinquish your inheritance that I gave you. I will make you serve your enemies in a land you do not know, for you have set my anger on fire; it will burn forever.<sup>5</sup> This is what the Lord says: Cursed is the person who trusts in mankind. He makes human flesh his strength, and his heart turns from the Lord. <sup>6</sup> He will be like a juniper in the Arabah; he cannot see when good comes but dwells in the parched places in the Uldr, whose confidence indeed is the Lord, is blessed. <sup>8</sup> He will be like a tree planted by water: it sends its roots out toward a stream, it doesn't fear when heat comes, and its foliage remains green. It will not worry in a year of drought or cease producing fruit.

<sup>9</sup> The heart is more deceitful than anything else, and incurable-who can understand it? <sup>10</sup> I, the Lord, examine the mind, I test the heart to give to each according to his way, according to what his actions deserve. <sup>11</sup> He who makes a fortune unjustly is like a partridge that hatches eggs it didn't lay. In the middle of his life his riches will abandon him, so in the end he will be a fool. <sup>12</sup> A glorious throne on high from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary. <sup>13</sup> Lord, the hope of Isrel, all who abandon you will be put to shame. All who turn away from me will be written in the dirt, for they have abandoned the Lord, the fountain of living water.


